



Fall Enrollment 2005-2009






Georgia residents comprise 92.16% of VSU's enrollment.





Enrollment by College





> Freshmen-29.63% Sophomores-17.14% Juniors—16.26% Seniors-19.88%



In Fall 2009, the average SAT score for Critical Reading is 510, while the average SAT score for Math is 500 for firsttime, full-time freshmen.
