



### Total Enrollment, Spring 2011–Spring 2015




**Total Enrollment by 5 Largest Declared Majors, Spring 2015**





## Total Enrollment of Georgia Counties with Highest Enrollment by Gender, Spring 2015




### **Total Enrollment by Residency, Spring 2015**




#### **Undergraduate Students by College, Spring 2015**





### Undergraduate Enrollment by Classification and Gender, Spring 2015




### Undergraduate Students by 5 Largest Declared Majors, Spring 2015














**Undergraduate Adult Learners by 5 Largest Declared** Majors, Spring 2015




**Total Enrollment for Distance Learning, Spring 2015**
