Introduction

This report is a visual summary of the perceptions of the 479 VSU graduate students who completed their degrees during the 2004-2005 academic year and returned the Valdosta State University Graduate Exit Questionnaire. There were 682 graduates total, creating a 70% return rate. It is anticipated that these results will be used by colleges and departments as one indicator of the effectiveness of the University's programs and services.





Age of Respondents




- 172 graduates were between the ages of 20-29.

Race/Ethnicity




- 58 graduates were Black, non-Hispanic.

• 60 graduates were male and 392 were female.


Anticipated Degree




- The majority of graduate students, 252, anticipated receiving the Master of Education degree.

Major Field of Graduate Study at VSU




Length of Attendance at VSU

Overall Graduate GPA











Percentage of Respondents by College









Use of Student Organizations





Use of Student Facilities




