

VoIP Conference Calling

This guide outlines how to establish a conference call on a VoIP telephone.

Conference calls allow for a **total of four (4) connected callers**—the initial caller (yourself) and may include up to three (3) additional people.

To Establish Conference Call

- 1. Dial the number of the first person to whom you would like to speak with.
- 2. During connected call, press the Conference button or [More] > Conf Softkey
 - a. The first party is on hold.
- 3. Dial subsequent phone number or extension.
- 4. Press the Conference button or Softkey again.

If necessary, repeat process to connect one additional caller; for a total of four people.

To End a Conference Call

- 1. Hang up the handset or press the Cancel Softkey.
 - a. Press Conf Softkey to end the conference and remain connected to the most recent call.
 - b. Depending on configuration, when the initiator disconnects, the conference terminates.
 - c. When a party leaves the conference call, an audio beep will sound.
