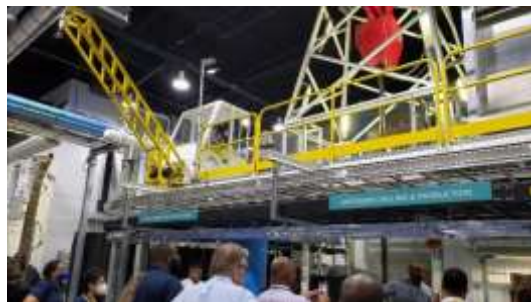

The Louis Stokes Midwest Regional Center of Excellence (LSMRCE) has published a special Research Topic volume in *Frontiers in Education* titled, “[New developments in pathways toward diversity and inclusion in STEM: A United States Perspective.](#)” **Dr. Kim Nguyen**, Principal Investigator for [LSMRCE](#) at IUPUI and Director of the [Indiana STEM LSAMP Alliance](#) boasts, “The LSAMP Special Edition includes 20 peer-reviewed articles, with 106 authors from 14 LSAMP Alliances, showcases a diverse broadening participation focus on the STEM disciplines, as reflected in the types of articles featured: 13 original research, 3 curriculum/instruction, 2 research methods, 1 literature review. The special volume shows that the LSAMP community has the capacity to engage in broadening participation STEM research, especially through existing partnerships and collaborations.” “Response to the volume has been tremendous with the articles receiving more than 45,000 views in the first 8mos of publication,” states, **Dr. Alec Gates**, Principle Investigator for the [Garden State LSAMP](#).
