

#### **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

**Beginning Freshmen** - Your acceptance is based upon previous academic records and Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) or American College Test (ACT) scores. VSU also requires a high school curriculum that meets the University System of Georgia's College Preparatory Curriculum. When necessary, a personal interview and/or other appropriate tests may be required.

**Transfer Students** - VSU requires an official transcript from each institution you have attended. You are required to have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better on all the college work you have attempted. Several programs of study have higher GPA requirements for admission into upper division coursework. If The major in Legal Assistant Studies has the central objective of training persons who are anticipating a career in support of the legal profession. The formal course work will lead to an understanding of the fundamental constitutional context of the American legal system. Students will also have the flexibility to choose from several substantive legal subject matters. The completion of the other requirements of the Bachelor of the Arts degree will ensure a broad educational experience.
